Please check with the elections department for your polling location. This seat is extremely important and those of you who are in Senate District 19 will need to come out in full force in November. Please encourage your family and friends to go out and vote as well!



CEC Meetings

In order, for us to hold productive CEC Meetings we will all have to work together to bring order, respect and openness to change. Due to last months' CEC meeting we will conclude our CEC at 8:00 p.m. If we have issues that have not been heard, we will need to table those issues to the following month in order to respect the agreement with the facility. We will work to open each meeting on time, so with that I am asking our Deputy Chairs to ensure that they are arriving on time, so that every precinct chair have the ability to obtain their badges. We will have a microphone on the floor and address those wishing to speak to use the microphone on the floor to be recognized. This will cut back on the amount of time we are using trying to hear from precinct chairs around the floor. As per our Continuing Rules on page 5, Article VII, E, 1. The general limits on debate in the CEC's meetings are that after the presentation of the motion, four (4) speakers for the motion and four (4) speakers against the motion will be heard, to be evenly divided among the four (4) commissioners' precincts, and they will be limited to speak for (2) minutes each.

Know Your Rights about POLITICAL SIGNS!

According to State Law, Texas Property Code, Title 11, Chapter 202.009, your Homeowner's Association MUST ALLOW:

- 1. At least one sign per Candidate / Ballot Item
- 2. Display of political signs of ANY SIZE up to 4X6 feet
- 3. Signs to be displayed at least 90 DAYS BEFORE and up to 10 DAYS AFTER the related election.
